ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS:

(Please read and initial indicating you understand and agree to the following statements)

_____ A Long Ear Rescue representative will visit the site in which the animal will be housed and that the housing must be approved by the LER representative prior to the animal leaving the facility.

_____ Unannounced health and welfare check may be done at any time by a representative of LER.

_____ Should the LER representative feel at any time that you are non-compliant with the adoption agreement and its requirements, LER retains the right to remove the animal from your property and return said animal to the LER facility.

_____ An adoption fee is charged for each LER animal. This fee is non-refundable and due when you receive possession of the animal. Adoption fees are non-refundable and are used to provide feed and veterinary services required by other animals at the LER facility.

_____ Any adopted LER animal must be kept on your property unless and until another facility has been approved by an LER representative. No animal will be adopted to a home where the animal will be boarded at another facility.

_____ Once an LER animal is in your possession, you assume ALL responsibility/liability for the animal. At any time should you no longer desire to keep an LER animal for any reason, the animal must be surrendered to the LER facility. No LER animal is to be sold, traded or given away.

_____ ALL male donkeys, mules or horses currently at the home MUST be gelded before LER will adopt a mare to the home. An adopted LER animal is NEVER permitted to be bred and that LER enforces a strict NO BREEDING policy whether intentional or "accidental".

_____ The home will be required to have some type of covering in the pasture so the animal is protected from inclement weather.

_____ An adopted LER animal requires an appropriately sized and regularly cleaned stall/run-in large enough to lie down comfortably with access to clean water at all times as well as proper nutrition consisting of hay and/or grain. Proper farrier and veterinary care including medications and/or supplements is also required.

Applicants found to have any connection to criminal cruelty, or any connection to a defendant of a case of criminal cruelty/neglect will not be considered an appropriate adoption candidate for an LER animal.

Long Ear Rescue reserves the right to correspond with adopters and conduct on-sight inspections of adopted animal(s) housing at your residence. An adoption contract is mutually signed granting LER the legal right to resume custody of an adopted animal(s) wherein the adoption terms have been violated in any way.
